

# **Town of Union PUBLIC HEARING**

**Thursday, July 26, 2007 & August 2, 2007**

## **On an Ordinance to Impose an Extended Stay on Construction of Large Wind Energy Systems in the Town of Union**

The Town of Union will hold two public hearings regarding a proposed extended stay on construction of Large Wind Energy Systems in the Town of Union. The purpose of an extended stay would be to give the Town time to develop permanent regulations relating to the construction of large wind energy systems. The first public hearing will be held at the Plan Commission meeting on Thursday, July 26, 2007. The second public hearing will be held at the Town Board meeting on Thursday, August 2, 2007. Both meetings will begin at 7 p.m. at the Eager Free Public Library, 39 W. Main Street, Evansville at 7:00 p.m. (use 1<sup>st</sup> Street entrance, lower level meeting room). Town board members and Plan Commission members may be in attendance at both meetings.

Please note that these hearings will address the process the Town should use to study and develop permanent regulations, time needed to do so, and the need for and duration of such a stay. These hearings will not address the larger issues of large wind energy systems themselves as that type of hearing will be part of the ordinance development process.
