Bids for 2008 Francis Park Mowing

The Town of Union will receive sealed bids for the Francis Park mowing contract. Contract requires the mowing of roughly 1.036 acres of grass parkland located in the Francis Addition during the 2008 growing season. Grass shall be maintained at a height of no more than 4 inches.

Bids for 2008 Town Roadside Mowing

The Town of Union will receive sealed bids for a roadside mowing contract. Contract requires the mowing of roughly 53 miles of Union Township roads between June 1 and June 15, 2008 and September 1 and September 15, 2008. Cuttings shall be one pass wide with a minimum 5' cut. A double wide cut is required within 300 feet' of intersections and 300 feet in front of cautionary signs. In addition, approximately .2 miles of mowing shall be done along the driveway of the Town of Union Refuse and Recycling Center off of Green Bay Rd.

Bid Requirements

Contractor must provide proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance. They must also carry worker's compensation unless proof of sole proprietorship is provided. Contractor must provide own mowing equipment and gas. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Submit sealed bid for the total cost in an envelope clearly labeled with which project is being bid upon, e.g., "2008 Francis Park Mowing Bid". Submit bid on or before April 30, 2008 to Regina Ylvisaker, Clerk, 10831 N. Hwy. 14, Brooklyn, WI 53521. Or bring sealed bid to the May 1, 2008 monthly Town Board meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the Eager Free Public Library (lower level meeting room), 39 W. Main Street, Evansville.
