

**TOWN OF UNION  
WORKING BOARD MEETING  
Minutes of Tuesday, May 13, 2014**

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The Town of Union Board working board meeting was called to order by Chairman Kendall Schneider at 6:01 p.m. on Tuesday, May 13, 2014 at Creekside Place, 102 Maple St., Evansville, WI. Members in attendance included Chairman Schneider, Town Supervisors George Franklin and Kim Gruebling, Treasurer Sharon Franklin, and Clerk Regina Ylvisaker.

**Board Action: Review and Approval of Class A Beer & Liquor License: Larry & Dawn Iverson, D & L Liquor**

The applicants have submitted an updated application, and Building Inspector Bob Fahey reported the building renovations are up to code. Motion to approve Class A Beer & Liquor license for Larry & Dawn Iverson for the remaining 2014-2014 licensing period made by Gruebling/Franklin. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

**Public Works Building**

Kendall Schneider has not received any quotes on cement work yet. He feels if the prices for cement work fall within 3% of the original contract quote it would be acceptable. Kim Gruebling noted that the size of the concrete pads has been increased since the initial contract quote, so an increase of up to 5% would be acceptable. Schneider thought the DNR grant money received by the Town for the Recycling Center should be put towards the cost of the pad. The Town receives approximately \$4000.

Motion to authorize approval of a contract for cement work for the public works building in an amount up to \$10,000 made by Gruebling/Schneider.

Discussion: Franklin thinks the issue should be tabled until actual numbers are received.

Roll call: Kendall Schneider - No; Kim Gruebling - Yes; George Franklin - No. Motion failed 2-1.

Treasurer and Clerk will be prepared at the next meeting with numbers on amount spent, amount returned on the public works building contract. The group also agreed to defer the decision on the recycling concrete pad. Gruebling would prefer it be a bit larger just to plan for the future.

**2014 Roadwork**

Motion made by Gruebling/Franklin to approve slag seal with Scott Construction in subdivisions as discussed in the amount of \$53,200, to include the following roads: Golf Air Drive, Birdie Lane, Ron Road, Francis Road, Forest Hollow, Glacier, Weary Road, Woodworth, North Field Crossing, Orchard View, Antler Court. Noted that this amount does not include the cost to do paver patch on Golf Air.

Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Motion to adjourn made by Gruebling/Franklin. Meeting adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
