BUILDING PERMITS

Building permits are required if you:

- build a new building 80 sq ft or larger
- add onto or remodel an existing building
- add or install new wiring, plumbing, heating, or cooling equipment
- build a deck on your home
- make structural changes to a building (rafters, bearing walls, etc.)

Building permits are NOT required if you:

- build a new building less than 80 sq ft in size
- repair existing electrical, plumbing, heating, or cooling equipment

If you are unsure whether you need a permit or not, please contact the Building Inspector **prior to beginning the work. If a permit is required and work has already begun, you will be charged double the permit fee.** Please also notify your contractors of the Town permit requirements and zoning code. A listing of permit fees, as well as Town of Union Zoning Code is available on the Town's website or by contacting the Building Inspector.
