6. Recycling Center Update

Legris reported the biggest issue now is people not breaking down cardboard and not taking recycling out of plastic bags. Wiser mentioned that additionally some people are putting items in the metal dumpster that don't belong (i.e. vacuum cleaners)

 Brooklyn Fire District Update Gruebling reported no update. Schneider stated the EFD will be getting a new tender next year. Contingency plan for EFD for voting, type up request and give to Kendall for consideration at next Fire Board meeting.

8. Public Comment (5 min max per item, no action will be taken on any issues) Doug Lee: questioning how to deal with noise issue. Having issue with milk hauler going through intersection and running jake brake down the road, causing excessive noise in the neighborhood. Has talked to both state patrol and rock county, who suggested having the town put up a no jake brake sign. Lee would rather have the board speak with the individual, feels a sign is more than necessary. This individual was previously not stopping at the intersection and lee called him in, feels this is retaliation for this call. Franklin will stop him Friday morning to talk with him. Add to next month's agenda, to see if it's resolved.

Lee also brought up not plowing across roads from driveways to ditches; would like the board to take some action on this issue at some time.

Also concerned about having audits done.

Add trailers on farm parcels and audits to next board meetings as discussion items.

Templetons in attendance questioning plans for migrant workers at Landmark. Plan Commission discussed at their last meeting and will have a public hearing at their next meeting for changes to the zoning district language.

Bob stated that there are a number of state regulations related to migrant housing that apply to the situation, it is not as simple as people might initially infer.

Rock county sheriff's deputy arrived at 7;12 pm, Lee reviewed issue with jake braking with him, will advise having an officer patrol the area.

Legris stated drivers are not stopping on territorial road; deputy stated they have had increased deputies in the area lately.
