Do I need a building permit?

YES, you need a permit if you:

✓ Construct a new building 80 sq ft or larger	✓ Construct a new building less than 80 sq ft
✓ Add on to or remodel an existing building	✓ Repair existing electrical, plumbing or HVAC
✓ Install new wiring, plumbing or HVAC	
✓ Construct a new deck on your home	
 ✓ Make structural changes to a building (rafters, bearing walls, etc.)

ATTENTION RESIDENTS: To ensure Fire, EMS and other first responders can quickly gain access to your home or other buildings in case of emergency, please note the following:

Driveways must be clear and open at least 16' in height and 24' in width. Brush, trees and other obstacles must be removed and maintained to ensure these minimum clearances. Failure to do so could result in a delay in first responders reaching your home in the event of an emergency.

PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION

Taxes are paid to the Rock County Treasurer. Tax payments can be mailed or delivered to:

Paying by Mail

- Include the Tax ID Number (located in the top right corner of your bill) on your check/money order.
- If paying more than one parcel with one check, list the Tax ID numbers and amounts for each parcel.
- If you would like a receipt, enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Paying In Person

Bring your tax bill(s) with you.

The Treasurer's Office accepts tax payments via cashier's check, personal check, money order or cash.

- Do NOT send cash in the mail. Cash is only accepted in person.
- If payment is made by check, the tax receipt is not valid until the check has cleared all banks.
- Make checks or money orders payable to: Rock County Treasurer

Credit Cards & Electronic Checks

Payments may be made by credit card or electronic check using the GovTech Services DSFwebsite.

- Call 1-855-912-ROCK or 1-855-912-7625 or
- Visit the GovTech Services website: https://www.govtechtaxpro.com/
- You will need the Tax ID number located in the upper right hand corner of your tax bill.
- The fee to use the credit card payment option is 2.20% of the total tax amount paid.
- The fee to use the E-Check option is \$1.50 per check. Multiple parcels may be paid with one E-Check.
- Allow 5-10 business days for a credit card or electronic check payment to be received by the Treasurer's Office.
